


Our Moment of Pride

Guru Parv was celebrated in school. Presentation of Shabads by the teachers and students of the school was appriciated by one and all.





Space


"An insight into the Celestial World"

Away from the normal routine, on 29th Nov.'08, 27 students of SPACE CLUB (VI_VII std.) went to Jewar for the overnight camp which was coordinated by Mr. A. P. Dubey and Mr. D. P. Singh.

J ewar is around 110 km. away from Delhi, where the space club members were allowed to stay overnight for a special experience. They were given very interesting information regarding the solar system and various constellations by the dedicated astronomers. The students observed the number of constellations such as the Orion constellation, Ursa Major constellation etc.

They were able to see number of bright stars, faint stars, their patterns and location.

Watchful round the night, at 3:00 a.m., they were able to see the meteor falling with beautiful colors. They could see the Saturn with its ring structure through a high powered telescope. A documentary film was also shown for better understanding of the constellation and the celestial bodies. It was an unforgetful educative, learning activity which is sure to leave its impact on the students.



Story Telling

There was an open debate on creating progressive culture of reading, writing and story telling. She emphasized on the need to teach children to read with an open mind; to give way to imagination through the usage of various triggers-like visuals, voice modulation, by emoting a situation and by reflecting over the context of the topic.

Overall the session was very informative and interesting. It was conducted with an easy to understand approach, aiming to break the cultural and international stereotype images, myths etc.

Mathematics Workshop

Mathematics workshop for teachers was organized by Oxford University Press on 1 st November 2008.

The motive of the Resource Persons, Mr. Jose Paul (Ex-Director, Educational Planning Group, St. Xavier's School, Delhi) and Mrs. Ashalata Badami, was to make the teachers familiar with their teaching methodology that aims at the dissemination of expertise and shared experience to bring about a change in the role and attitude of teachers. They introduced the activity method of teaching Mathematical concepts which allows a teacher to take mathematics beyond the curriculum.

In this workshop the effort was made to innovate concepts to encourage children to reflect on their own learning and to pursue imaginative activities and questions. The participants were urged to recognize that given space, time and freedom, children generate new knowledge by engaging with the information passed on to them by adults. Inculcating creativity and initiative is possible if we perceive and treat children as participants in learning and not as receivers of a frixed body of knowledge.

A large number of participants from nearly 20 schools were extremely receptive to the approach of the resource person.
