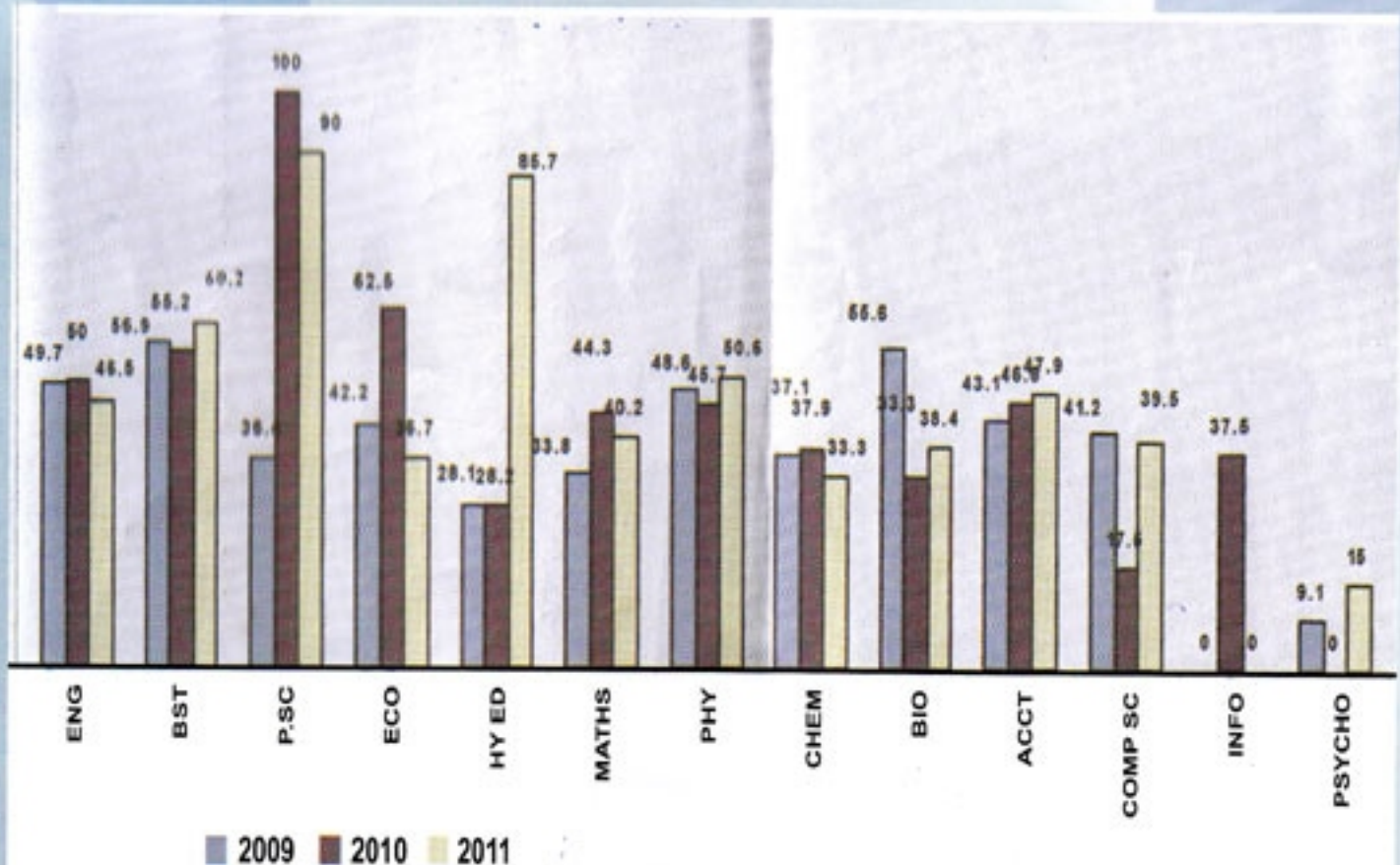

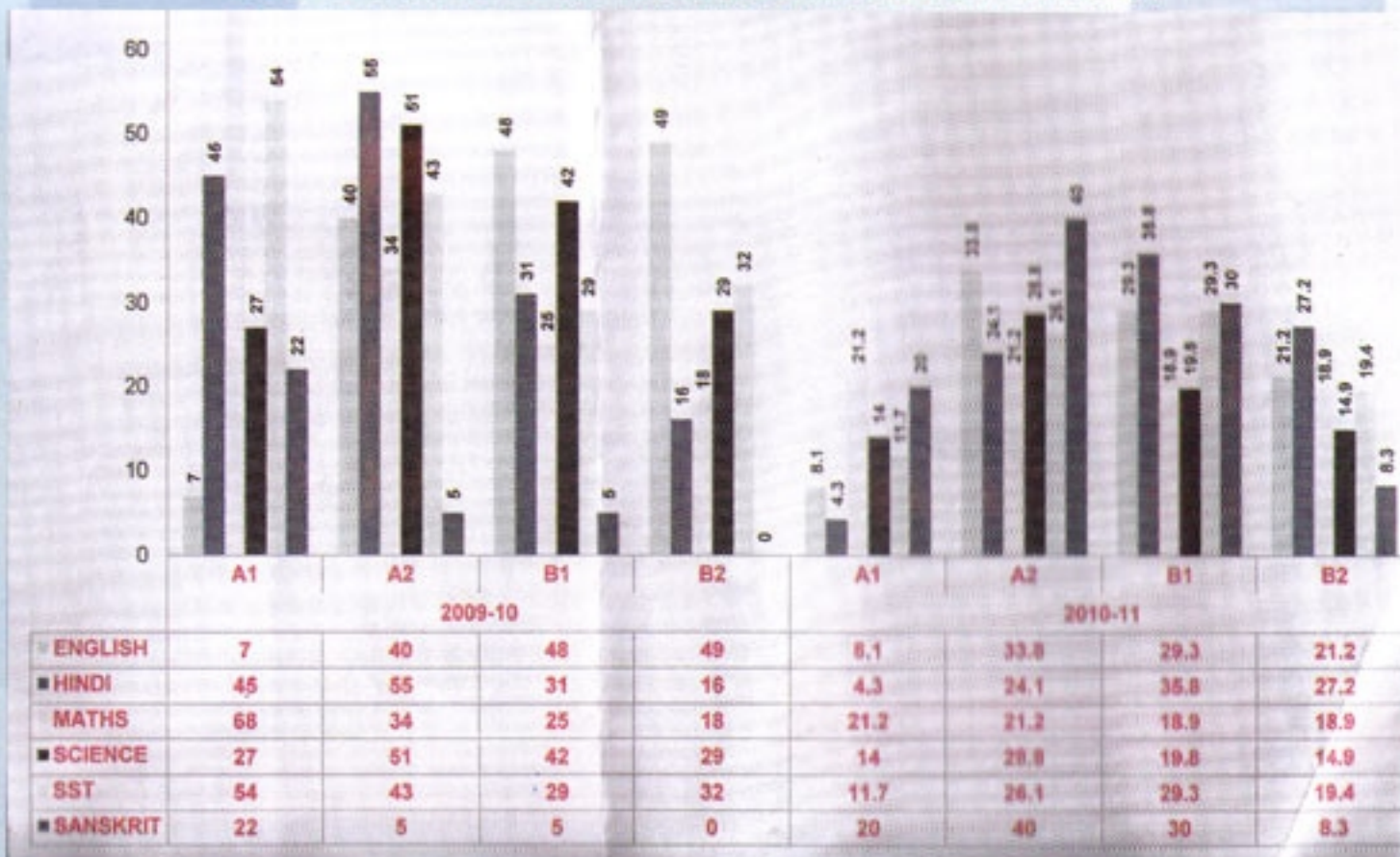

Cricket-O-Mania

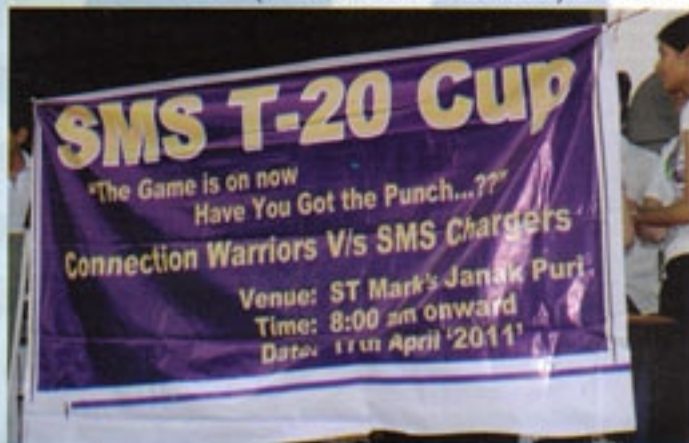
