OUR STUDENT DELEGATION IN INDONESIA

A nine member student delegation comprising of Sahil Gandhi (XE), Ruchi Jain (XD), Amit Rajput, (XC), Navya Chawla (XG), Anurag, (XC), Vibhor Goel (XD), Rahul Bhandari (XE), Deekshant Khitoliya (XC) and Pankit Arora (XF) accompanied by teacher in-charge, Ms. Anita Vohra, of our school visited Al Azhar High School, Jakarta , Indonesia from January 12 to January 22. The students stayed with the host families. During these ten days, the students were exposed to a variety of activities at the school. They learnt traditional dance and martial arts. They also attended several English classes wherein they gave their presentations too. The students also took time out to explore the city life and visited the National Monument of Indonesia (Monas), which is the landmark of Jakarta, the Gajah (elephant) Museum, which showed the traditional houses of Indonesia, costumes, jewellery and the miniature of the biggest temple of Indonesia (Borobudur) etc. and also the Sea World where they could see a variety of marine creatures. They also visited Bandung, a small hill station where they learnt how to play a traditional instrument of West Java called the 'Ang Klung'.

The students visited the ASEAN Institute where they participated in a Peace Dialogue. The highlight of the trip was the visit to the Indian Embassy in Jakarta and meeting the Hon'ble Ambassador, Shri Biren Nanda. It was indeed a trip to remember for everyone as it taught the students better understanding, tolerance towards other cultures as well as improving language and life skills needed by the students to confront global challenges.

Lectures were given by Dr. Madhu and Dr. K. K. Sharma who are avid bird watchers. Mr. Farhan Contractor gave an excellent presentation on how people of Rajasthan are doing Rain Water Harvesting by making Beris and Step Wells which has led to increase in the water table, thereby making agriculture possible in areas, where previously women had to walk for 7-8 hours to just get a pitcher of water.

Bird watching was a wonderful experience, when aquatic birds were shown in Ana Sagar Lake in front of RIE University (Regional Institute of Education). Students got the opportunity to see rare species of birds like Yellow Footed Green Pigeon, Drongo, Babbler, Stilt, Lapwing and Ducks like Mallard, Shovler, Egrets, Dabchick, Pintail etc.

The Paryavaran Mitra Quiz was the central event of the entire programme in which our students outshone other schools from various states. In the final round there were five finalists from the states of Delhi, Chandigarh, J&K, Chhattisgarh and Punjab. Our students topped the quiz with the massive total of 115 points.
