BIDDING ADIEU

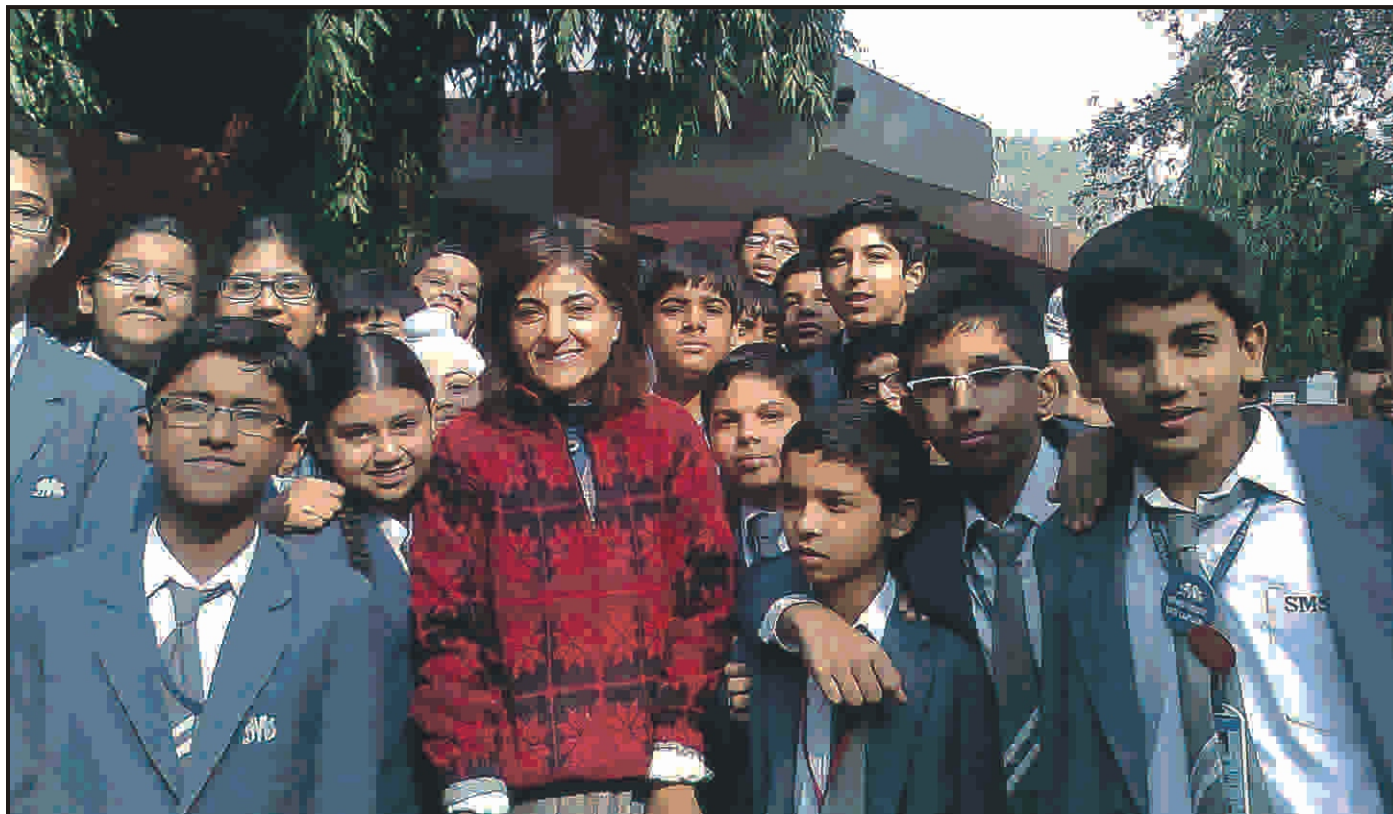

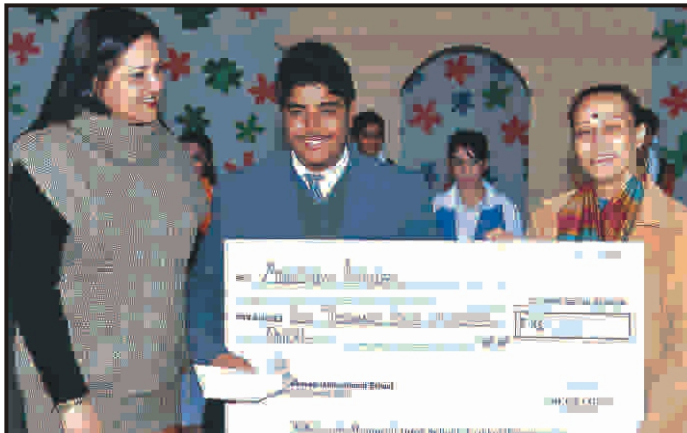

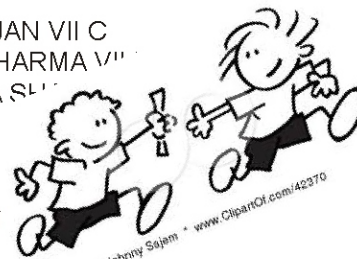

STUDENTS PARTICIPATE IN CBSE HERITAGE QUIZ

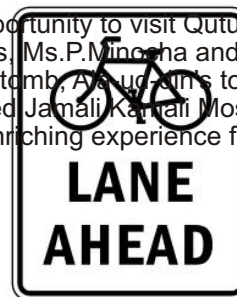

TRASH FESTIVAL ATTENDED BY STUDENTS
