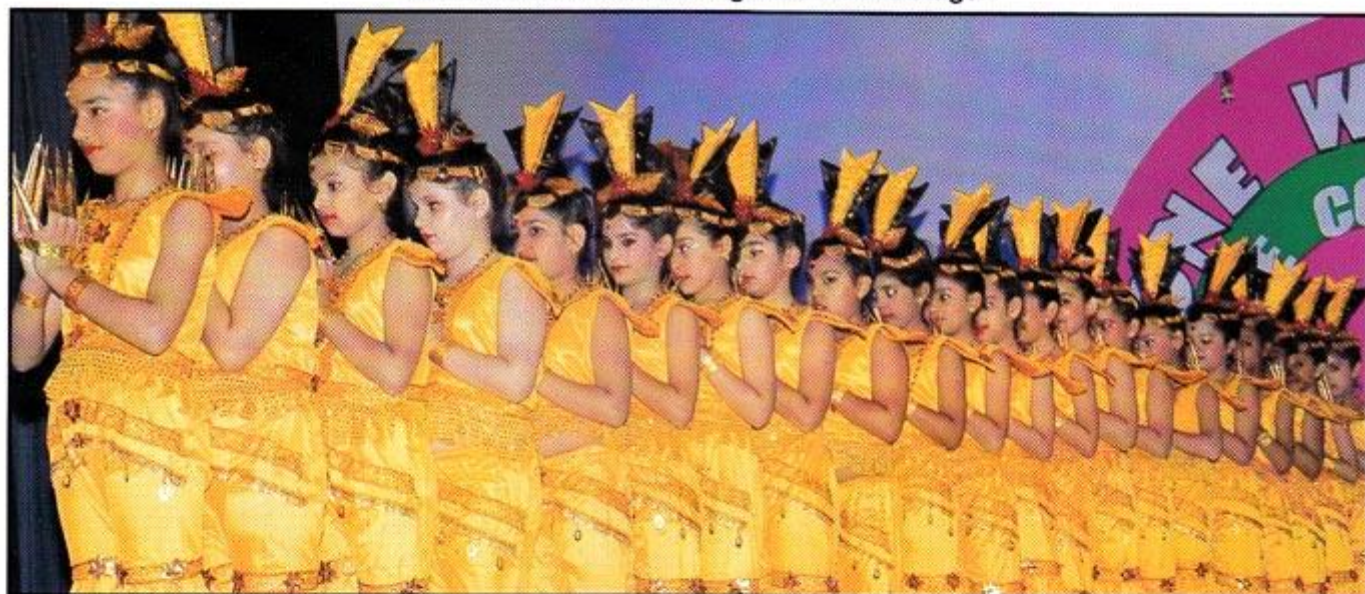

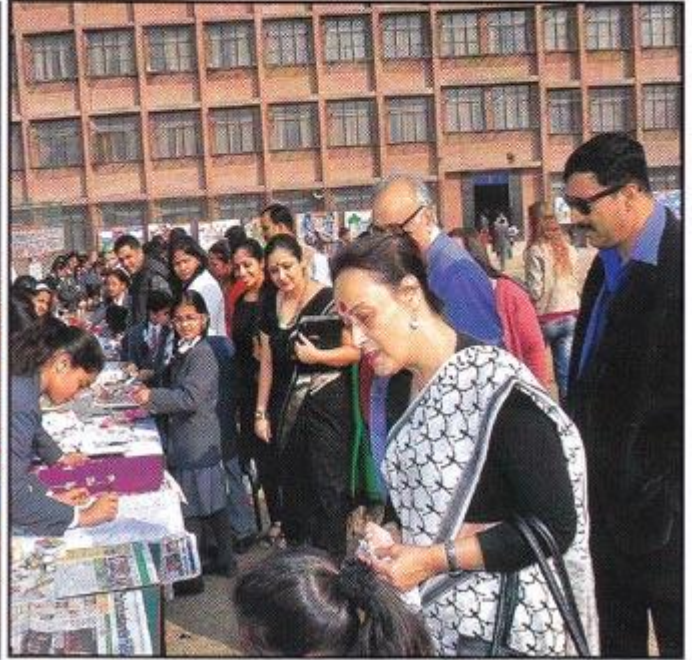


## CANVAS FOR CREATIVITY : ART & CRAFT EXHIBITION

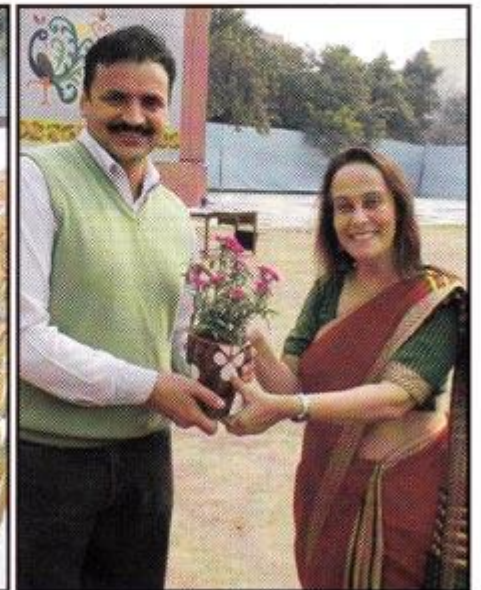
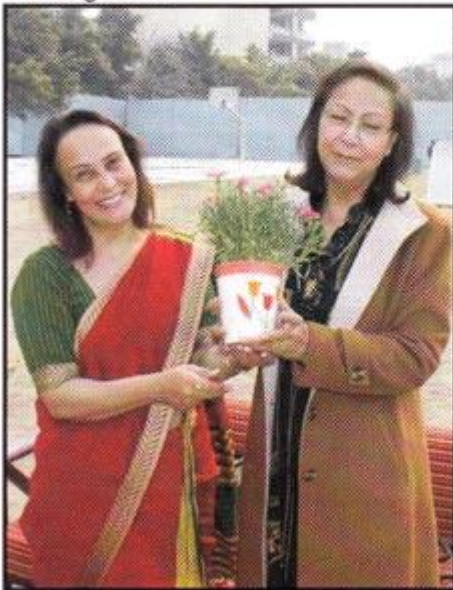

## BUSINESS PLAN AWARD

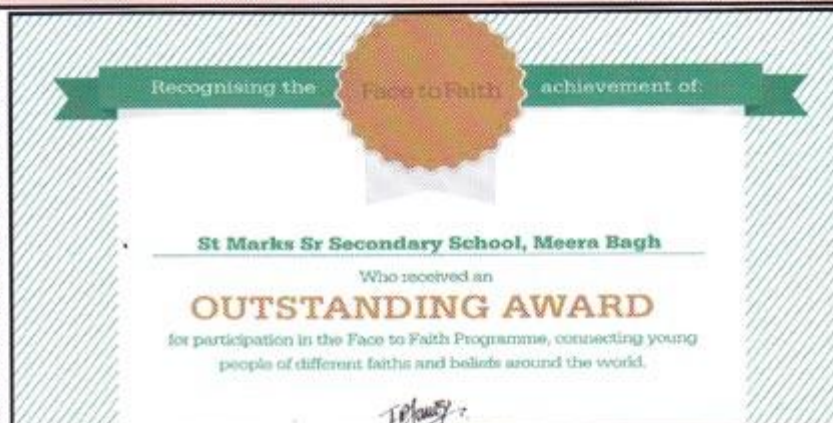


Our Global Coordinator, Ms. G. Rajan receiving the Outstanding Business Plan Award from the Deputy Director, Ministry of Education, Nepal.

Our school received the **Outstanding Business Plan Award, implemented under School Enterprise Challenge 2013**. School Enterprise Challenge is a project run by British Council under the aegis of Teach a Man to Fish, London. In a glittering ceremony at ITC Sonar, Kolkata, the school received the award from Dr.B.K.Ranjit, Deputy Director, Curriculum Development Centre, Ministry of Education, Government of Nepal. We have been running Nirman Enterprise under the aegis of School Enterprise Challenge for the past two years. Nirman Enterprise is an endeavour which helps in providing employment opportunities to women from the economically weaker sections of the society. The women are provided with material to stitch cloth bags which are then sold by the students during PTMs, exhibitions and other events. The money generated by the sales is then divided as their income amongst the women thus making them earning members of their families.

## FACE TO FAITH GOLD AWARD

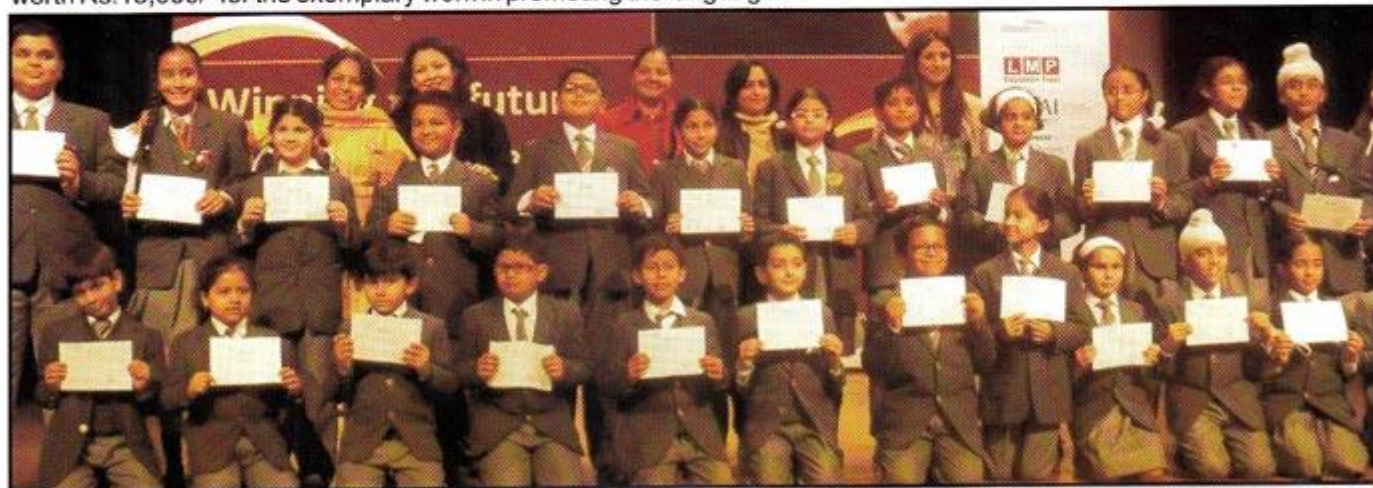

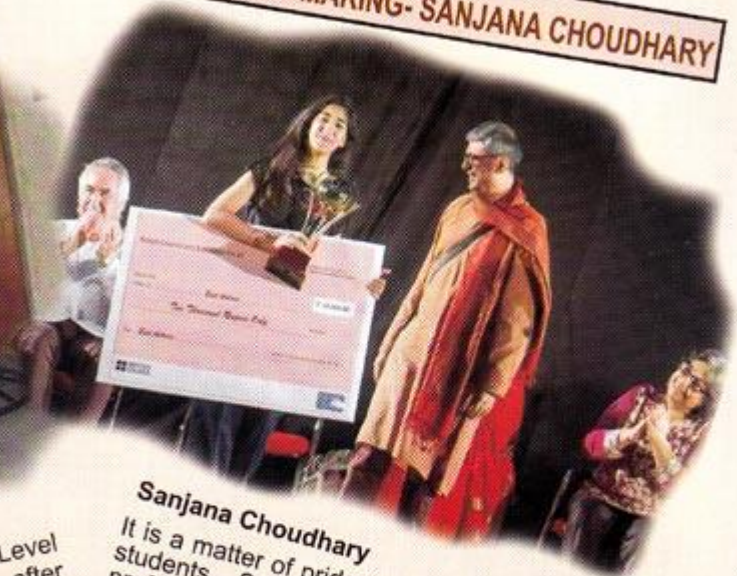
SKY IS THE LIMIT- FLIGHT TO NASA

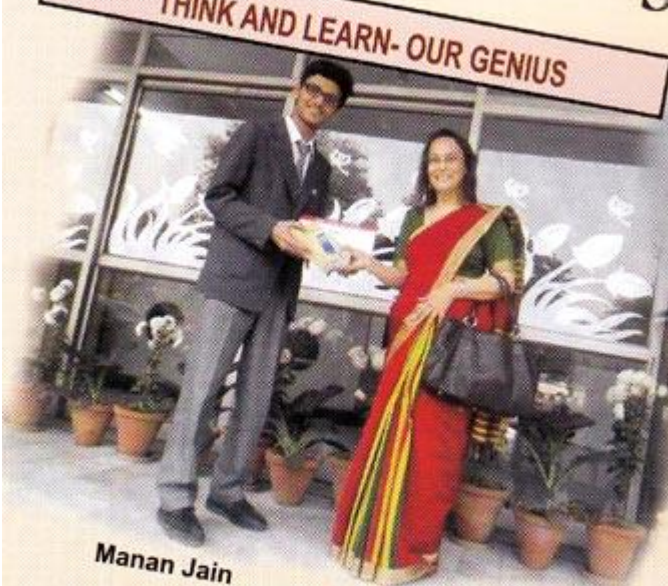

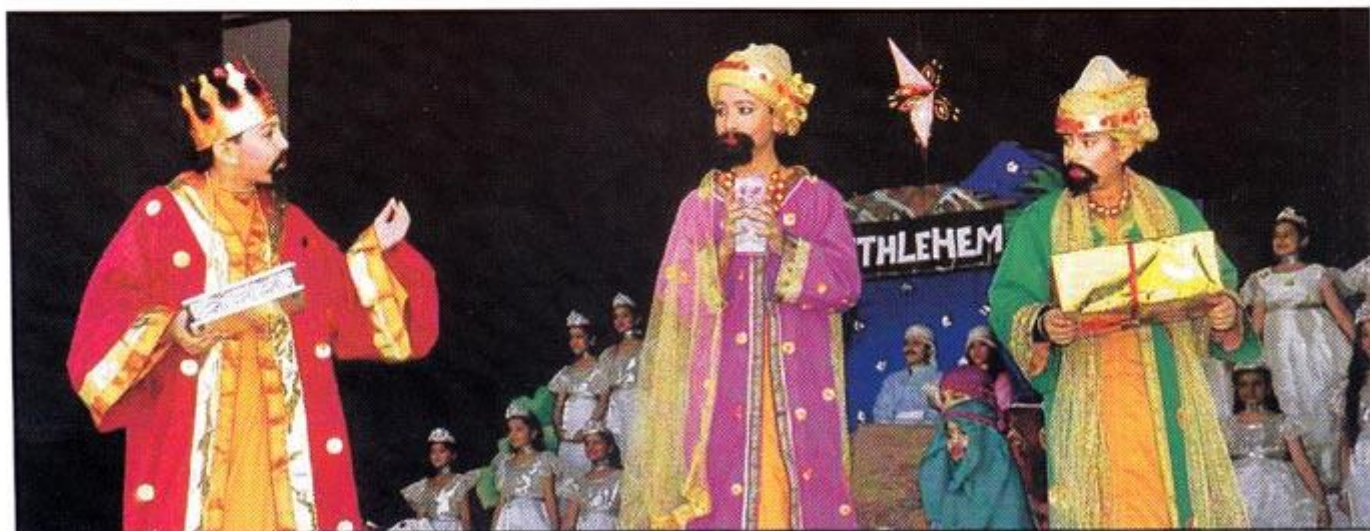

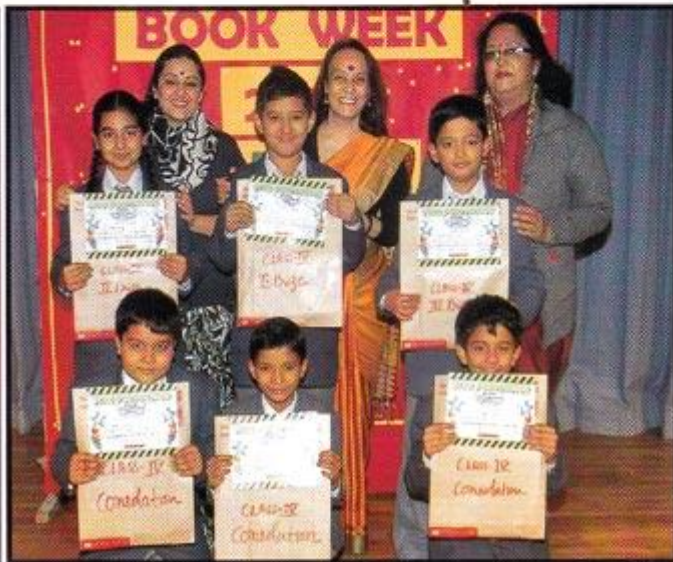


## BOOK WEEK

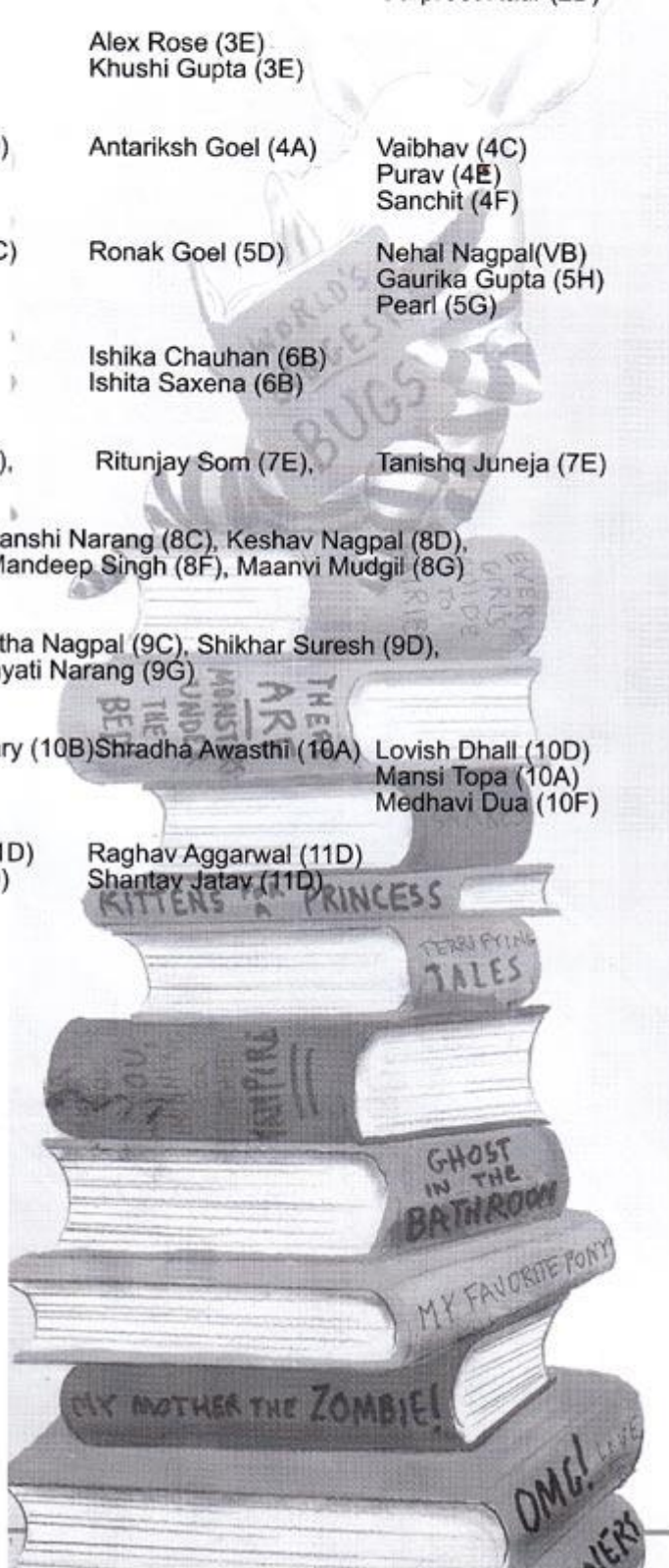
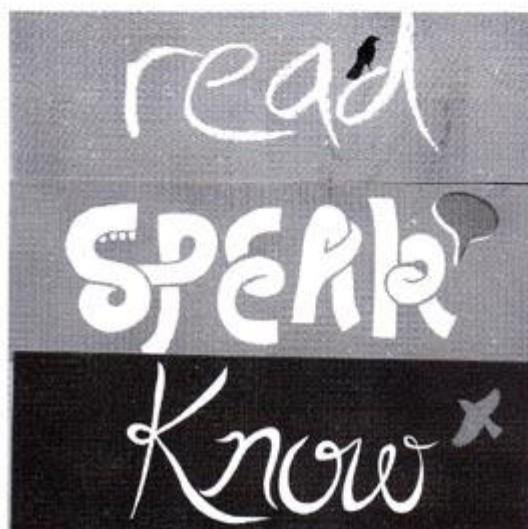
## NCC RALLY

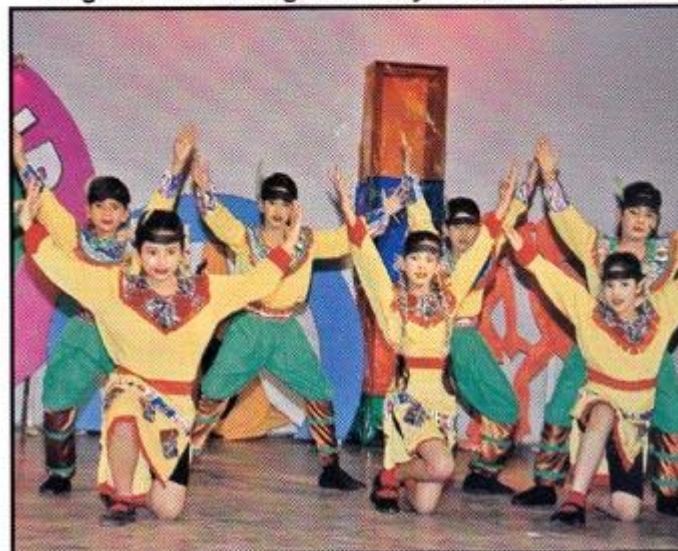
