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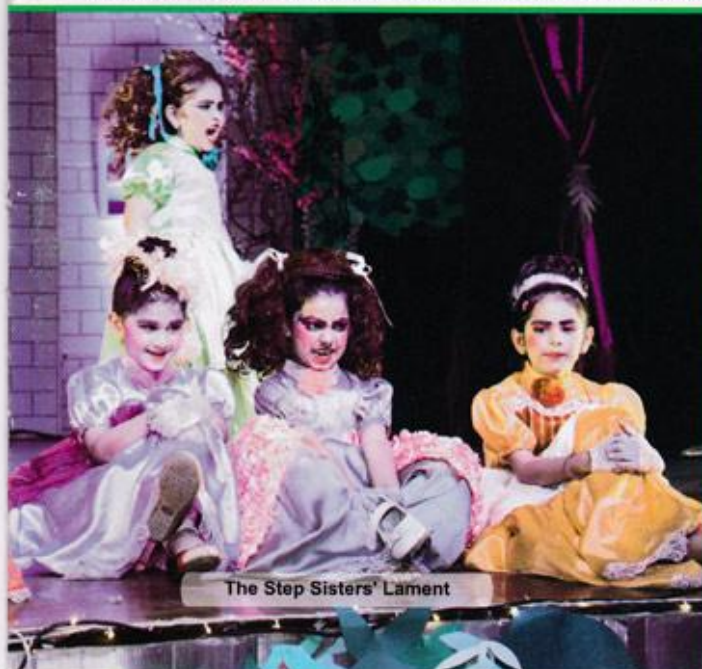
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## EDITORIAL

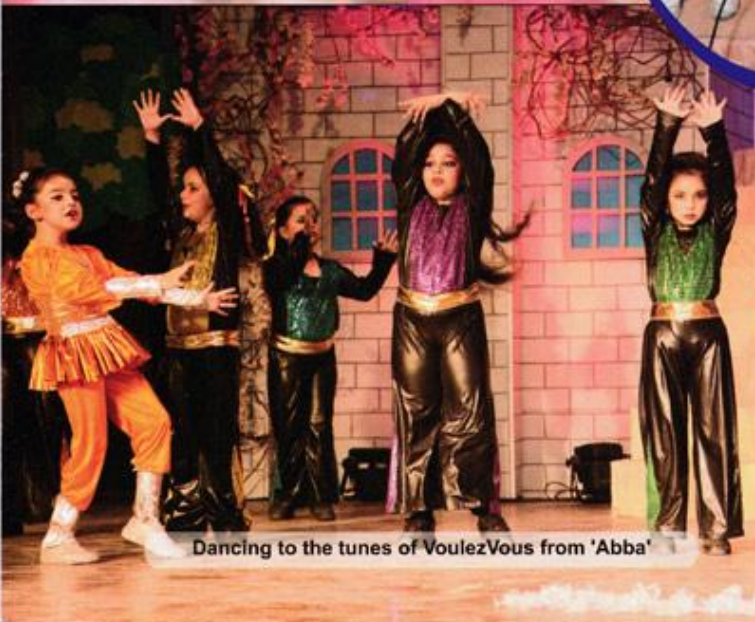

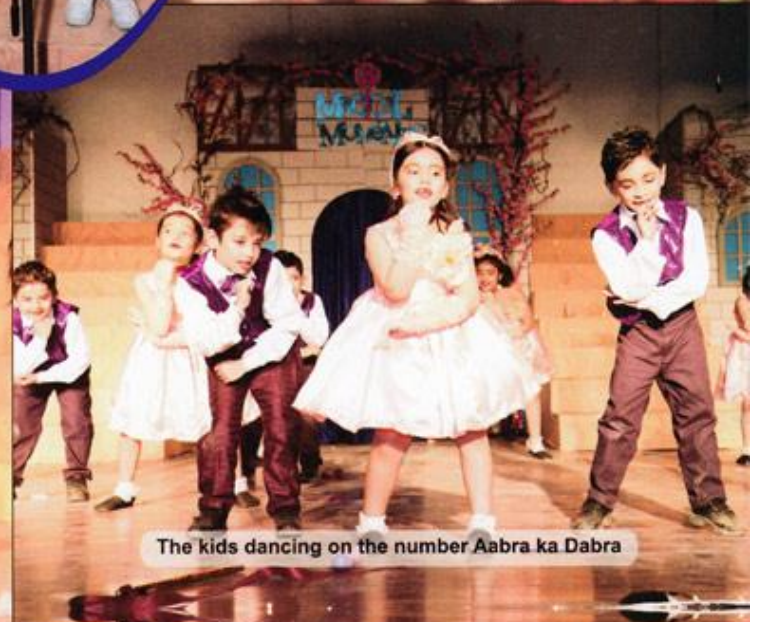

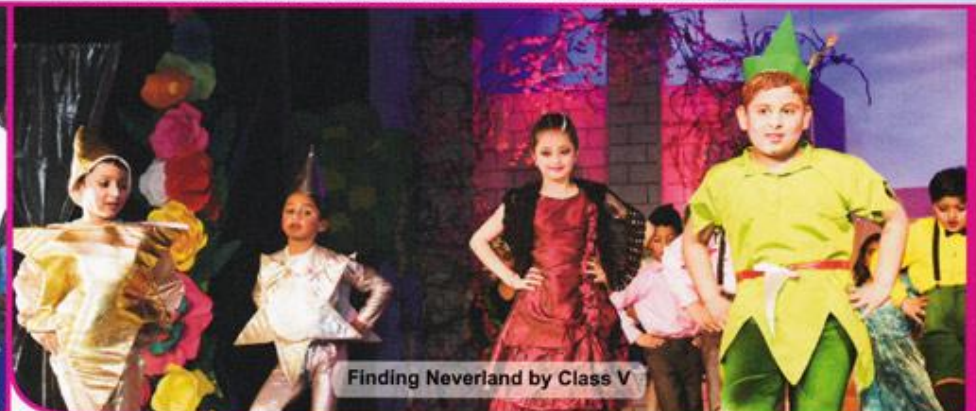


## DREAMZ UNLIMITED

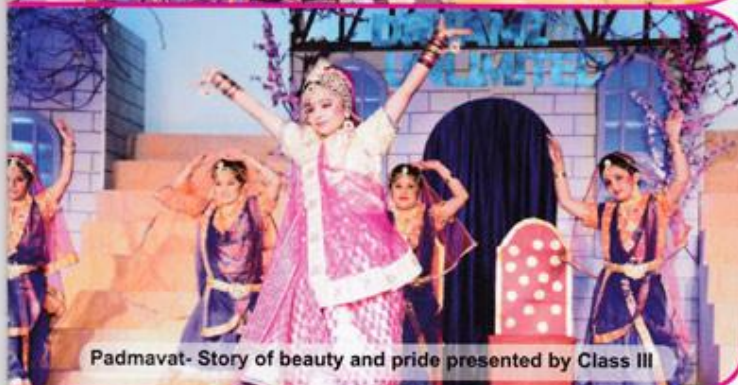

### SCHOOL LEADERSHIP SUMMIT

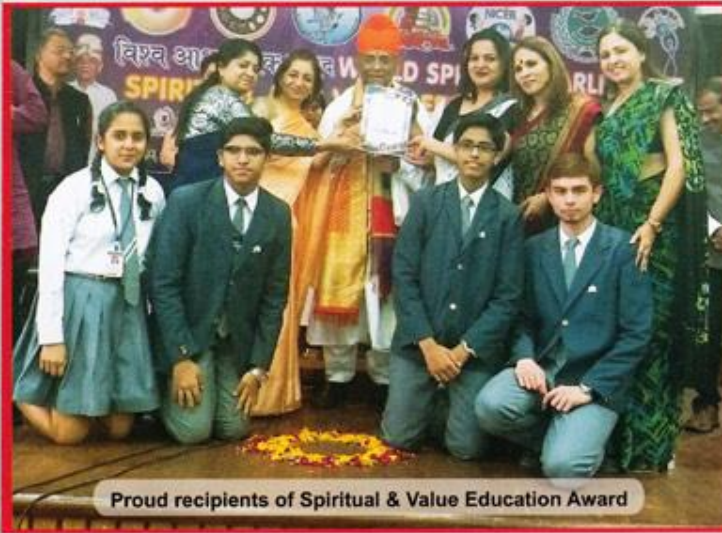

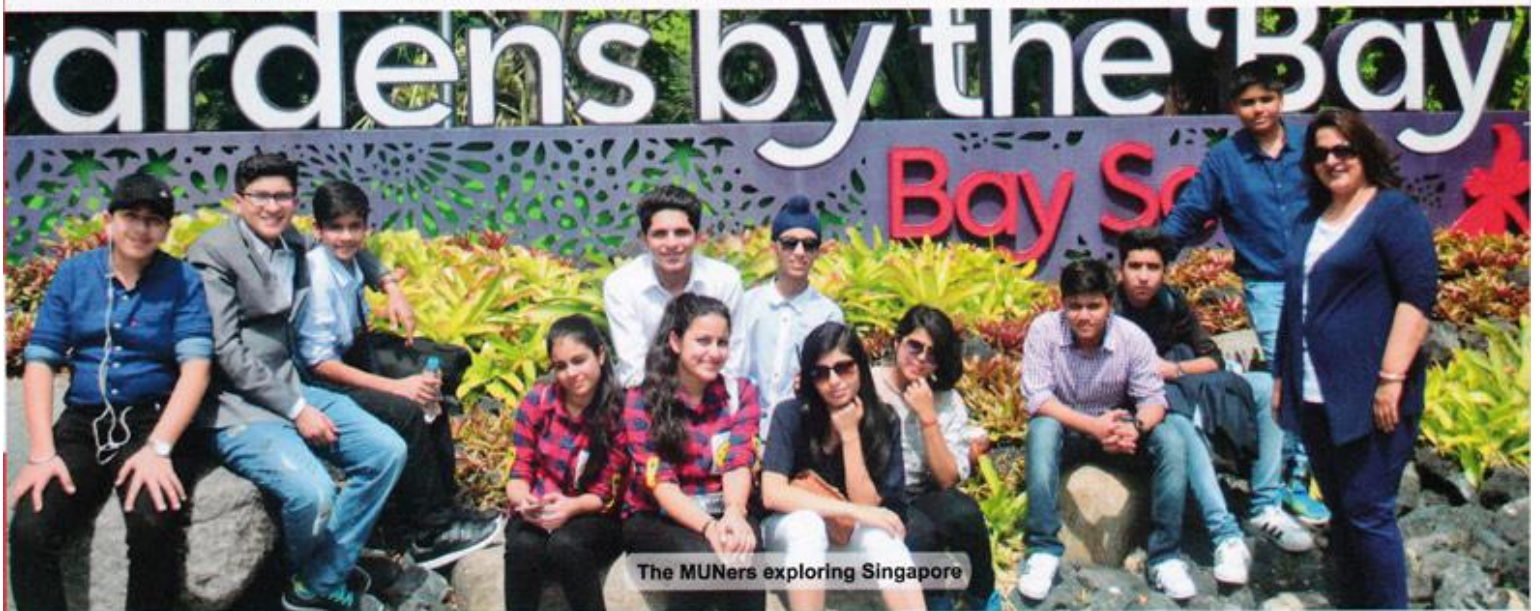
## GLOBAL DIMENSIONS

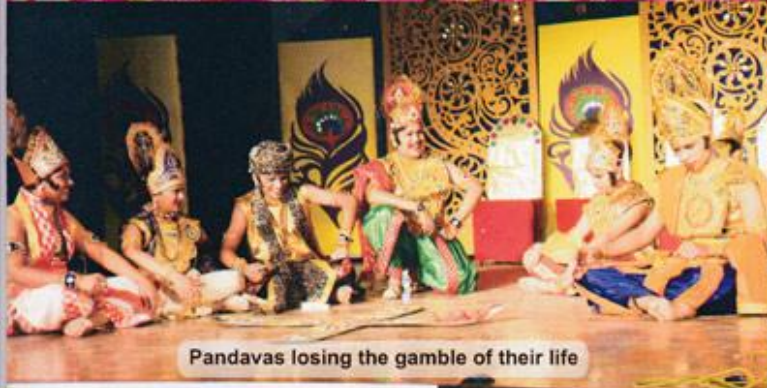

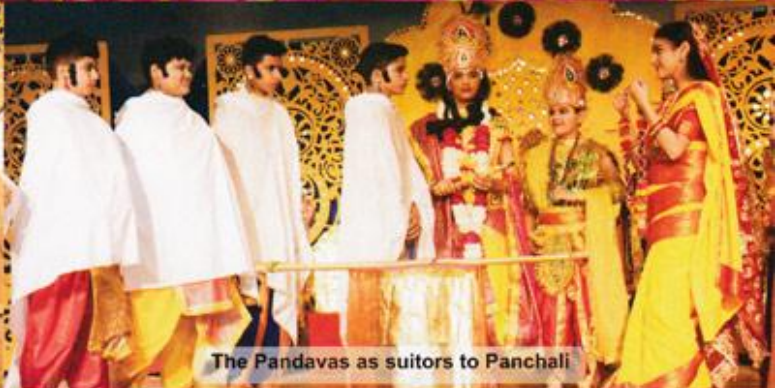

## BOOK WEEK

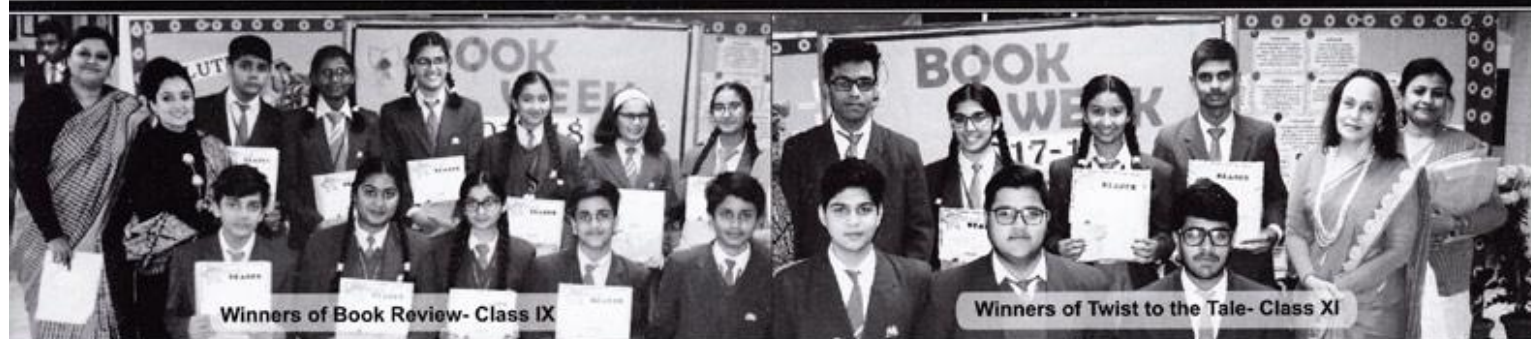

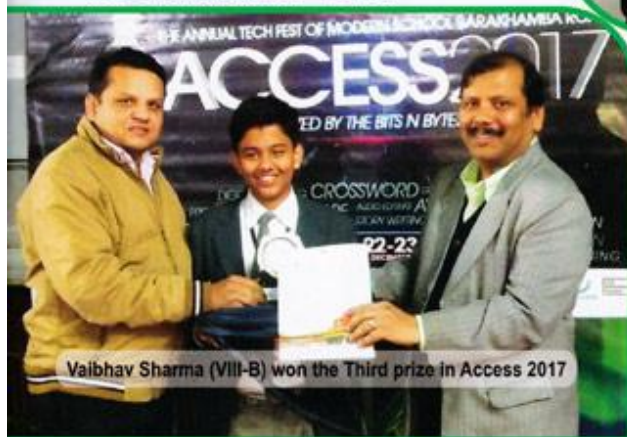


## INTERNATIONAL LEVEL COMPUTER CHAMPIONSHIP

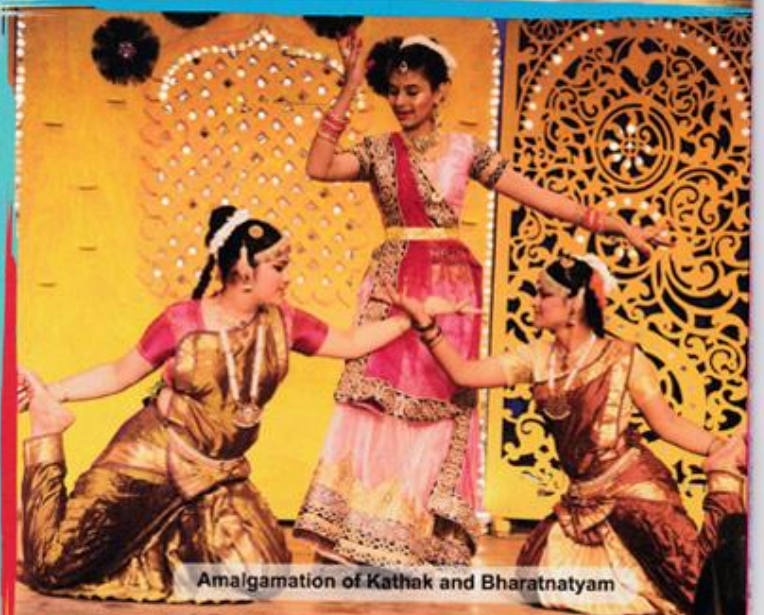

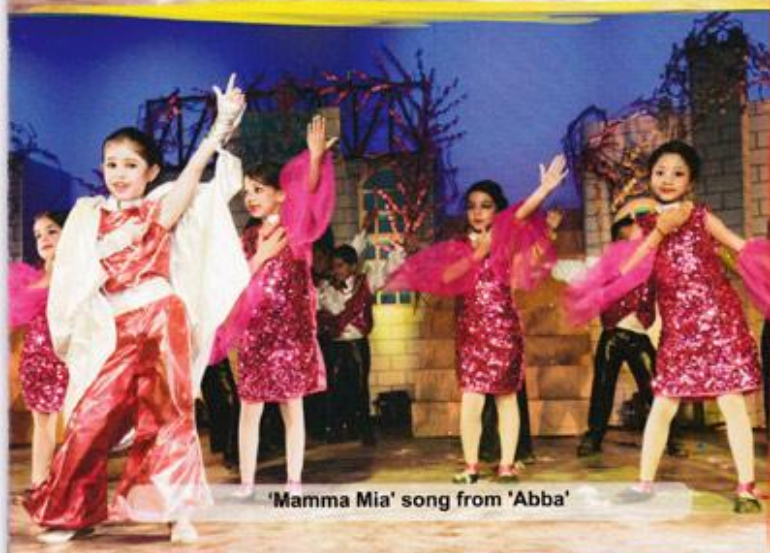

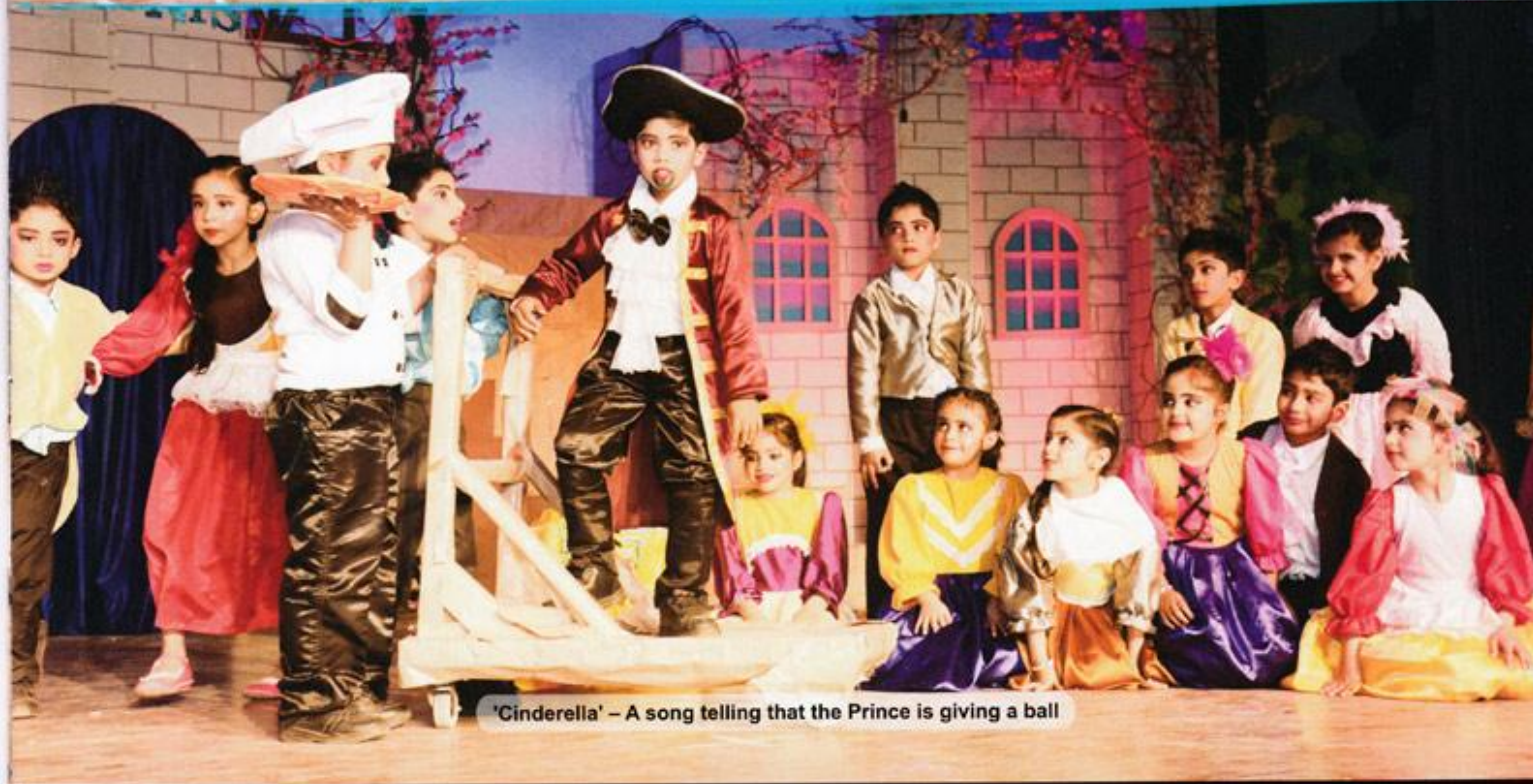

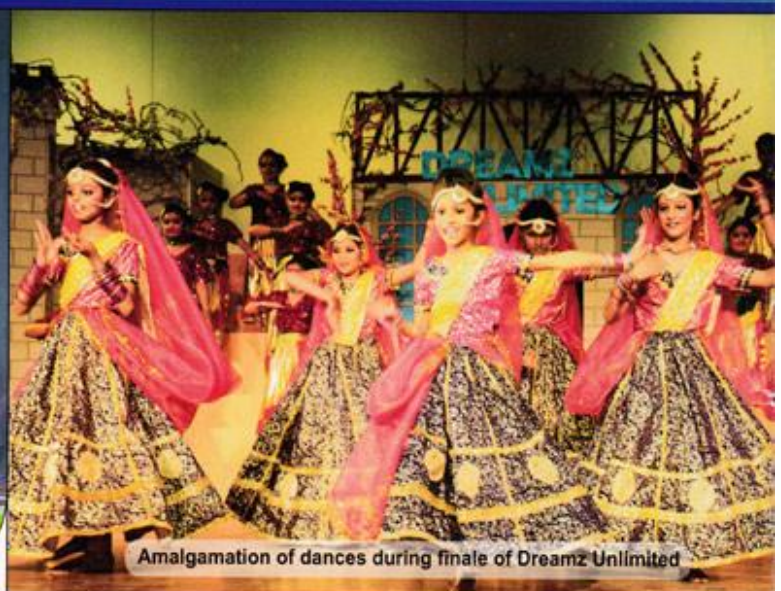

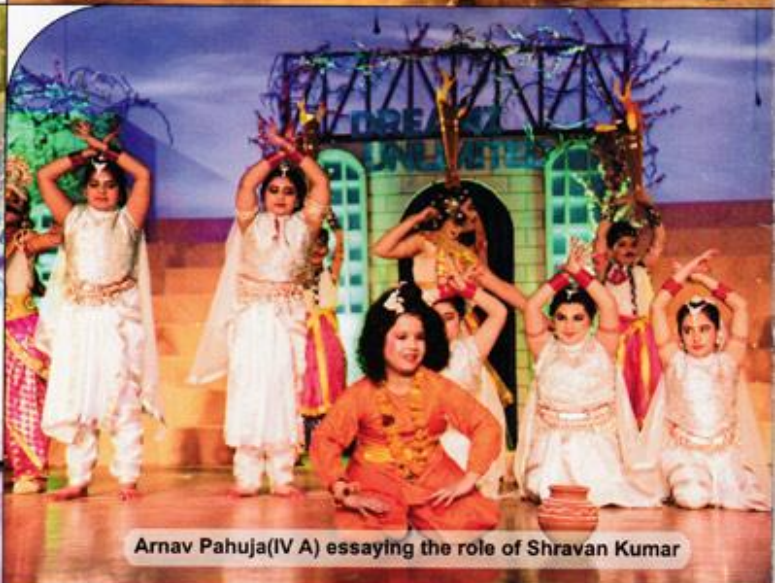
